After a military career as a fighter pilot, Dror joined Elbit System in 2001 as an engineer to lead the Research and Development of new innovative commercial Enhanced Flight Vision System product line. Elbit's EFVS products is the basis of the company latest greatest success in the diversification process that adds commercial aviation to the company customer base.

On 2011, Dror was appointed as the company Vice President for commercial aviation, as part of Elbit Aerospace division. Under his leadership, Dror led the introduction of new EFVS technologies to business aviation, first time EFVS for commercial helicopter and the introduction of wearable HUD technology for the Air Transport market.

Dror holds a B.A. in computer science and an Executive MBA degree from Tel Aviv University. His piloting experience consist of 22 year of flying fighters, trainers and commercial airplanes.

Heinz Leibundgut was trained as a professional helicopter pilot in the USA. On his return from America, he became a licenced helicopter mechanic and helicopter instructor at Heliswiss AG. Subsequently, he performed operations for Heliswiss in Switzerland, as well as in Mauritania, Peru and Greenland.

Between 1984 and 1986, Heinz Leibundgut was employed by Eliticino SA as a transport pilot and flight instructor for the helicopter types, AS350, SA315 and Bell 47. In 1986, he became a pilot at Helog AG, flying the AS332 Super Puma. In 1990, he consolidated his successfully completed instrument flight training by performing flights to oil and gas rigs off the coast of Scotland and Norway. In 1992 Heinz Leibundgut was appointed Chief Pilot/Head of Flight Operations at Helog. He joined Rega as a Nominated Person Flight Operation (NPFO) and Head Flight Instructor in 1999. Since 2011, Heinz Leibundgut has headed the Helicopter Procedures and Training division and is a member of the Management Board.
